

PRIVACY POLICY

XSPlatforms. ("XSPlatforms," "we," or "us") knows that you care about how your personal information is used and shared. This Privacy Policy explains what information we collect, how we use this information, and how you can control the collection, correction and/or deletion of information.

This Privacy Policy applies to our websites, www.xsplatforms.com, www.fallprotectionxs.com, www.facadexs.com, www.suspendedxs.com and www.scaffoldxs.com and all subdomains from our websites, also referred to as "**websites**".

We will not use or share your information except as described in this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy applies to information we collect via our websites, and does not apply to information we collect by other means (including offline) or from other sources. Capitalized terms that are not defined in this Privacy Policy are explained in our [General Terms and conditions](#).

1. Collected information

- 1.1 **User-Provided Information:** You provide us information about yourself, such as your name, e-mail address, and other personally identifiable information (all referred to as "**Personal Information**") if you opt in to download one of our materials from one of our websites, request information and like or follow our social media channels. If you correspond with us by email, we may retain the content of your email messages, your email address and our responses.
- 1.2 **Data regarding your visit(s)** to our website and any resources used are collected. The following is included and not limited to: location data, weblogs, traffic data, and any other communication information.
- 1.3 **Third Party Analytics Services:** XSPlatforms uses third party analytics services. Read how Google uses data when you use our Service and how you may opt out (www.google.com/policies/privacy/partners). We also use [LinkedIn Analytics](#), [Drip](#) and [MailChimp](#).

2. Cookie Usage

There are instances where we may use cookies to gather information regarding our services in a mathematical collection for our website.

Any information collected will not have identifying data. It is statistical data about our visitors and how they have used our site. No personal details will be shared that could identify you. We may assemble information about your common internet use with a cookie file. When used, the cookies are downloaded to your computer automatically.

The cookie is stored on the hard drive, with transferred information. The data sought by the cookie helps us improve our website and any service offered to you. Your browser has the ability to decline cookies. This is done by setting your browser options to decline all cookies.

We may do this by providing you with articles, information, personal mailings and newsletters about work at height solutions. We may also provide you with information about promotions, which may be of interest unless you have asked us not to.
- 3.3 To improve our offering - monitoring and analyzing the information we hold about you and our other customers in order to make informed decisions about our products, services, websites and advertising.
- 3.4 To analyze the use of our websites and make suggestions and recommendations to you about products or services that may interest you.

4. How We Share Your Information

Personal Information. We will not disclose Personal Information to any third party unless required to do so by law or subpoena or if we believe that such action is necessary to:

- a. conform to the law, comply with legal process served on us or our affiliates, or investigate, prevent, or take action regarding suspected or actual illegal activities;
- b. to enforce our [Terms of Service](#), take precautions against liability, to investigate and defend ourselves against any third-party claims or allegations, to assist government enforcement agencies, or to protect the security or integrity of our Site; and
- c. to exercise or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of XSPlatforms or stakeholders.

5. How We Protect Your Information

- 5.1 Locations outside the European Economic Area may be used for transferring data we collect about you. These data sites are for storing or processing of your information. The information we store outside the European Economic Area may be shared with staff based on the process and storage of said data. It may include such processes as processing a payment or offering support for your service or product needs. The staff processing or storing information may work for our suppliers outside the European Economic Area. By submitting your data to us you have agreed to this transfer and storage of data. We take all reasonable action to ensure the safety of your personal data in agreement with this Privacy Policy.
- 5.2 Information we are provided with will be stored on secure servers. Transaction data is encrypted for your safety.
- 5.3 We care about the integrity and security of your Personal Information and implement appropriate technical and organization security measures to safeguard your Personal Information. We cannot, however, ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to XSPlatforms or guarantee that your information on the Service may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed by breach of any of our physical, technical, or managerial safeguards.

6. Compromise of Personal Information

In the event that Personal Information is compromised as a result of a breach of security, we will promptly notify those persons whose Personal Information has been compromised, in accordance with the notification procedures set forth in this Privacy Policy, or as otherwise required by applicable law.

7. Your Choices about your information

- 7.1 Unsubscribe from emails. To unsubscribe from a particular newsletter, click the "unsubscribe" link at the bottom of that email newsletter;
- 7.2 Inspection and access: you can request from us a summary and a copy of any Personal Information we hold about you;

- 7.4 Portability: you may request that we send you any Personal Information that you have provided to us or ask that we send this information to a third party;
- 7.5 Objection: you may object to us using your Personal Information where we use it based on our legitimate interests to do so;
- 7.6 Restriction: you may request that we restrict the processing of your information where you believe it is inaccurate, our processing is unlawful, you believe we no longer need the information or if you have objected to our use of it; and
- 7.7 You always have the right to lodge a complaint with the relevant supervisory authority for data protection in your jurisdiction.

8. Children's Privacy

Protecting the privacy of young children is especially important. For that reason, we do not knowingly collect or solicit Personal Information from anyone under the age of 13 or knowingly allow such persons to register as Members. If you are under 13, please do not send any information about yourself to us, including your name, address, telephone number, or email address. No one under age 13 is allowed to provide any Personal Information to or on our websites. In the event that we learn that we have collected Personal Information from a child under age 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information as quickly as possible.
